How long does MRI keep your data for?

MRI will keep your data until the earlier of:

- Twelve months following the end of our contractual relationship with the client or MRI
- Twelve months following the data on which the user or client removes the personal information
- By submitting a verified erasure request

What are your rights?

Depending upon the state in which you are located, you may be afford particular rights, these include:

- Right to be Informed about the Personal Information which is being collected on you.
- Right to see the specific pieces of Personal Information which have been collected and that we currently hold on to you twice in each twelve-month period.
- Right to have your Personal Information Deleted
- Right to know if your Personal Information is Shared or Sold
- Right to Opt-Out
- Right to Non-Discrimination
- Right to Appeal



Can Children use the Service?

- The earliest age someone can register for the service is at 13.
- If it is found that a user under 13 is utilizes the service, their data will be removed.

Do we sell your data?

- No, MRI does not sell, rent or intentionally disclose personal information that has been provided to
 use on the Site to any third party.
- The only exceptions to this include:
 - Where MRI is required to disclose your personal information by law, regulation, warrant, subpoena or court order.
 - Where MRI is required to in urgent circumstances to protect the personal information of MRI
 employees, users of MRI products or services, or members of the public, or to enforce
 provisions of the Terms of Use, or where such disclosure is required in a sale or transfer of
 all assets or stock of MRI.
- Express valid authorization is required to sell anyone's data under the age of 16.
